Regulations Olympos Futsal Competition



- **1. Schedule**: From the time stated on the match schedule, the players have successively:
- a) a maximum of 5 minutes warming-up time;
- b) 20 minutes of playing time during the first half;
- c) a maximum of 5 minutes half time rest;
- d) 20 minutes of playing time during the second half.
- **2. End of match:** The referee must ensure that the times of the match schedule are respected. In other words, the match must be finished at or before the time of the next game (i.e. start of warming-up time of next match). In the case of the last match of the day, the referee must ensure that this match is finished no later than 50 minutes after the start of the match according to the match schedule.
- **3. Match ball**: The home team (listed first) provides a match ball! This ball can be collected from the Service Desk using the OlymPas.
- **4. Referee**: The match schedule indicates which team should arrange the referee. This team will be scheduled to play before or after the match it has to referee.
- **5. Referee absent (1):** If the referee does not turn up, the winning team from the previous match will arrange the referee. NB: See also Article 10.
- **6. Shirt colours**: If two teams have similar shirt colours, the away team must provide shirts in another colour or play in vests (to be borrowed from the Service Desk).
- **7. Cancellation**: Unfortunately, it is almost not possible to cancel matches and reschedule. To register for the competition, you must be able to provide a team on all match days. Cancelling a match, without consequences for the deposit, is only possible in very exceptional circumstances to be assessed by the organization. If the match can't be rescheduled, the match result will be an automatic 0-5 loss for the absent team.
- **8. Team absent**: in case of a no-show, the match result will be an automatic 0-5 loss for the absent team without refund of the deposit.
- **9. Referee absent (2):** Cancelling a team's turn to arrange a referee is only possible in very exceptional circumstances. When cancelling more than 24 hours in advance and in very exceptional cases, there will be no consequences. In case of UNANNOUNCED non-fulfilment of the refereeing obligation, three points will be deducted and there will be no refund of the deposit.
- **10. Repeat offence:** After two breaches of Article 8 or 9 without notice, the team will be expelled from the competition without refund of the contribution fees. After two breaches of Article 10 without notice, the team will be expelled from the competition without refund of the contribution fees and deposit.
- **11. Misbehaviour:** In case of extreme misbehaviour (e.g. fights in general, aggression towards the referee, ignoring time penalties), to be judged by the organisation of the Olympos Futsal Competition, the team involved will face an automatic 0-5 loss and the entire misbehaving team will be expelled from the competition without refund of the contribution fees or deposit. If the misbehavior occurs in the last period of the season then the punishment will extend onto the following season.

NB:

The referees must ensure that the results of matches are recorded in the match results folder. The results may also be submitted to the organisation digitally.
